"Am I due for a Wellness Visit?" You may have called them "physicals", "annuals" or "check-ups"

At the Markham Family Health Team, you can access your Physician or Nurse Practitioner for a comprehensive *Wellness Visit* using the schedule below

2y - 20y every 1 - 2 years

•immunizations as required

21y - 39y every 3 years

- •immunizations as required
- cancer screening (females)

40y - 64y every 2 - 3 years

- •immunizations as required
- diabetes and cholesterol screening
- cancer screening

65y and older every 1-2 years

- •immunizations as required
- cancer screening
- •chronic disease screening and/or management

For ongoing health issues that require regular follow up, please see your Physician or Nurse Practitioner as advised.

## Cancer Screening for average risk individuals

Cancer Care Ontario <u>www.cancercare.on.ca</u>

<u>Breast Cancer</u> – females age 50-74y; **mammogram** every 2 years (after age 74 with referral from primary care provider)

<u>Cervical Cancer</u> – females age 21-70y; **Pap test** every 3 years (can stop at age 70 with 3 normal Pap tests in the last 10 years)

<u>Colorectal Cancer</u> – males and females age 50 – 74y; **Fecal Occult Blood Test** (FOBT) every 2 years; for those at increased risk because of a family history of one or more first-degree relatives with a diagnosis of colorectal cancer, colonoscopy is advised

You and your health care provider may decide that more frequent screening is appropriate for you
